

Gas Chromatography Institute

Dr. Herman A. Szymanski, Chairman of the Department of Chemistry, has announced that the department will hold its Sixth Annual Gas Chromatography Institute from March 30 to April 3. There will be representatives of colleges and industries from all over the country. Seventy-five reservations have been accepted with more expected.

Two sessions will be run simultaneously. An elementary session will be provided for those having no background in the study of gas behavior. The emphasis will be on practical chromatography. The intermediate session is designed for those desiring a strong introduction to theory and practice.

Dr. H. A. Szymanski also announced an NMR Spectroscopy Institute running from June 8 to June 13, and an Infrared Spectroscopy Institute August 24 to 29.
