## Salamone Appointed Rector of LeMoyne

Father Ramon A. Salmone, SJ., presently the chairman of the chemistry department, is leaving Canisius to become the rector of the Jesuit Community at Le Moyne College, Syracuse.

Father Salamone explained that his new post gives him the responsibility for the spiritual, as well as the material welfare of the Jesuits residing at Le Moyne. His recommendation came from the Jesuit Provincial of the New York Province, but the actual appointment was made by the General of the Society of Jesus, in Rome.

THE APPOINTMENT is for six years, therefore Father Salamone has resigned his post at Canisius, and does not expect to return. He has been with Canisius for eight years as an associate professor of Chemistry, and was chairman of the department for the last three years.
