

Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Scholarship Criteria

Students who receive the MLK scholarship will be able to renew their scholarship for four years while studying at Canisius. The scholarship is administered by the Canisius Opportunity Programs for Education (COPE) office. The following criteria must be met by students each year in order to receive the scholarship award of \$1,000.

- Cumulative GPA of at least 2.25
- 10 hours of service per semester in a community setting that fulfills a social justice mission
- MLK Scholars will meet with a COPE mentor twice per semester to select service placements, and to monitor personal and academic progress
- Be a first-time freshman entering Canisius in Fall 2010
