



# SUNY Erie to Canisius College

## CORE CURRICULUM TRANSFER GUIDELINES

These general guidelines show how courses from SUNY Erie serve to complete Canisius College's Core Curriculum requirements. Note that the SUNY Erie course must be a regular course at the 100 level or above and must count for a minimum of 3 credits. Students must earn a course grade of C- or better for transfer credit to apply. It is possible that courses not listed here might be applicable to Canisius Core requirements; students may request a review of specific courses by contacting the Associate Dean of the College of Arts and Sciences. Students can transfer a maximum of 60 credits to Canisius from SUNY Erie or any other two-year college.
